**LEGENDS AT SPARKS MARINA RENO-TAHOE OPEN
FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT
AUGUST 3, 2008**

AN INTERVIEW WITH BRIAN DAVIS

Q. Brian, obviously a disappointing day for you, we'll just get some comments if we can.
BRIAN DAVIS: Yes, I'm hugely disappointed. I got off to a fast start, which I needed to, and it was playing much tougher today, the pin positions were just brutal. The greens were like concrete and it was just really tough. I hit a lot of good shots and it didn't really pay off again. I was trying to execute the really perfect shots sometime, but I'm not trying to play for second. It is just disappointing. But it's just one of them things. I won't say I'm disappointed because I still finished second, because I didn't play that bad. But it was playing tough out there today.

Q. Was there a point where you thought that it's out of reach now?
BRIAN DAVIS: No, not on the front nine, he didn't play well. He wasn't playing well. He didn't play well. I think he hit three greens in regulation.

Q. He hit 5 all day?
BRIAN DAVIS: I don't think he hit 5. He was really struggling with his game. I always knew coming on the back nine was going to be tough, I've been there before. Once I got a couple up on him, and I got unlucky. I hit one in the bunker, made a double on 14, and that was it then, it was gone. Up 'til then, you know, four out, I'm only four shots away, but with that finish, you've always got a chance. It was just one of them things. It's just one of them things, very disappointing.
