NATHAN GREEN, ROBERT GAMEZ LEAD TEAMS TO VICTORIES IN WEDNESDAY'S PRO-AMS FOR LEGENDS AT SPARKS MARINA RENO-TAHOE OPEN

Reno Resident Scott McCarron Ties for Low Score with 6-under-par 66

RENO, Nev. (July 30, 2008) – Nathan Green and former Las Vegas resident Robert Gamez guided their respective teams to victories in Wednesday's Pro-Ams for the Legends at Sparks Marina Reno-Tahoe Open.

Green, one of nine Australians in the field, joined Al Wheeler, Kirk Smith, Joe Drago and Raymond Bae in recording a stellar 19-under-par 53 at the Montréux Golf & Country Club that featured a back-nine 25. That not only helped the team to victory in the morning pro-am, but it was the lowest team score in the three pro-ams.

It bettered two-time U.S. Open champion Lee Janzen's team, which came home one shot back. The team of Janzen, David Swanson, Robert Sands, Tom Flaherty and Craig Holt would have won Monday's pro-am or Wednesday afternoon's pro-am with their 18-under 54 score. Dicky Pride and his team of Roy Nider, Bill Heals, George Vahsholtz and Simon Tao were one shot back with a 17-under 55.

Gamez's team of Ted Power, David Hughes, Daniel Rowen and Avan Acevedo captured the afternoon pro-am with that 18-under 54 score. That was a shot better than John Merrick's team, which consisted of Steve Krause, Gary Bush, Dan Ott and Tom Brown. Merrick's team needed a card-off (lower back-nine score) to edge Parker McLachlin's squad of Ken Mercurio, Bob Holmes, J.P. Glenn and John Glenn, which also finished at 17-under 55.

Reno resident Scott McCarron tied Ted Purdy for the low score among professionals. Both carded 6-under 66s.

Now it is the turn of McCarron, Purdy, Gamez, Janzen, Merrick, Pride, Green and the rest of the PGA TOUR pros to take on Montréux as the 10th anniversary edition of the Legends Reno-Tahoe Open begins today with all four rounds televised live on Golf Channel.
